



# Hawaii

## Three Island Holiday

### Day 1 (D)

This morning we will board our flight for beautiful **Honolulu, Hawaii**. Upon arrival we will transfer to the **Outrigger Reef on the Beach** hotel where we will check in for three nights. This lovely hotel has been freshly renovated and offers accommodations that abound with modern elegance and the lush spirit of Hawaii. Dinner is included this evening at the **Shore Bird Restaurant & Beach Bar** located in our hotel.



### Day 2 (B, D)

Following breakfast at the hotel we will depart for **Pearl Harbor** to visit the memorial site that led the United States into World War II. Our tour will begin with a 20-minute film that shows live footage of the attack. Then the group will be shuttled via naval launch to the **USS Arizona Memorial** where you can pay your respects to the 1,177 fallen soldiers. View the marble wall that has all of their names on it, as well as the 'black tears,' which is the oil that is still seeping out of the ship more than 65 years after the attack.



Our final stop at Pearl Harbor will be a visit to "Mighty MO," the **USS Missouri**. The Battleship Missouri has served her nation with honor and distinction through three wars, with the service and devotion of her crews spanning three generations. The site of the formal ending of World War II, today she stands proudly as an international icon of strength for freedom.



Next, we'll take a **tour of Honolulu** to see Chinatown, the Capitol, Iolani Palace and other highlights. The afternoon is free for you to enjoy our beachfront hotel or shop nearby.

This evening we will enjoy dinner at the **Hula Grill Restaurant** and then take our seats for the **SOS Show!** Repeatedly voted the best show in Waikiki by "Honolulu Magazine" readers, the **Society of Seven** is a *must see* for audiences of all ages! Blending their own humor and dramatic skills with dazzling musical talents, this upbeat and contemporary group has headlined at the Outrigger Main Showroom for more than three decades!



### Day 3 (B, D)

We will have a leisurely morning that includes breakfast at the hotel. Late morning we will depart on a narrated tour of Oahu. We will stop at the **Dole Plantation** for pineapple sampling and then continue our tour through the North Shore of Oahu. See famous Waimea Bay, and Pipeline and Sunset Beaches – the most popular surf spots in the world!

This afternoon we'll visit Oahu's famous **Polynesian Cultural Center**. Experience the seven South Sea cultures that collectively shaped this island paradise. View an **IMAX film** about these island cultures, and see the **Rainbows of Paradise** – Hawaii's only waterborne canoe pageant.



You'll also take a **guided canoe ride** from one end of the park to the other. A fabulous buffet dinner is included at the **Gateway Restaurant** followed by the award winning **Horizons Night Show**. This is sure to be the crowning moment of your PCC experience, as a cast of more than 100 young Polynesian performers enchant you with their enthusiasm, grace, endurance and beauty.



#### Day 4 (B, L)

Have breakfast at the hotel before checking out and boarding our inter-island flight to the **Big Island of Hawaii**. On arrival in **Hilo**, we'll explore the slopes of **Mauna Loa**. Our first stop will be at **Green Point Nursery** where you will have a glimpse into Hawaii's floral industry. See premium anthuriums, orchids and other tropical plants as they thrive on the slopes of a volcano. Then we're on our way to **Hawaii Volcano National Park**, home of the only "drive-in" volcano in the world. Lunch will be included at the crater's edge. Upon our return to Hilo we'll stop at the **Mauna Loa Macadamia Nut Farm** before checking into the **Hilo Hawaiian Hotel** for one night.



#### Day 5 (B, L)

After breakfast at the hotel we'll depart for another fun day of sightseeing. Our first stop will be at the **Pacific Tsunami Museum**. The museum serves as a living memorial to those who lost their lives in past tsunami events. See the exhibits and hear the incredible stories of Tsunami survivors. Then relax and enjoy the lush tropical countryside of the **Hamakua Coast** with its cascading streams and waterfalls, fertile valleys, mountains of lush greenery and spellbinding seascapes. We arrive at what was once the largest sugar plantation in Hawaii and is now the birthplace of diversified agriculture. Enjoy a rare visit and gourmet lunch at **Hawaiian Vanilla Vineyards**, the only one of its kind in the U.S. Then we're on our way to visit a **Kona Coffee Farm** to learn how this world-famous cup of coffee gets from the field to your cup.



This afternoon we will stop at the **Waipio Valley Lookout**, **Waimea Town** and the **Parker Ranch Center** in beautiful **Kamuela**. Parker Ranch was founded in 1847 and is one of the oldest and most historic ranches in the United States. Encompassing thousands of acres across the island, Parker Ranch is also among the country's largest cattle ranches.



On arrival in Kona we will check into the **Royal Kona Hotel** for a two-night stay.

#### Day 6 (B, D)

After breakfast we'll visit the **Original Hawaiian Chocolate Factory** to see how cacao is grown and processed into a chocolate bar right at the plantation. Next stop is **Kealahou Bay** at **Honaunau** to visit a real **Heiau** or Hawaiian temple and to learn about the Kapu System. By mid afternoon we'll return to the hotel so you can enjoy some leisure time. Dinner tonight will be at **Don the Beachcombers**.



#### Day 7 (B, L)

After breakfast at the hotel we will catch a morning flight to **Maui**. Upon arrival we will take a scenic tour of the **Iao Valley**, an area conquered by King Kamehameha in 1790. We will learn the history of this tropical paradise and then travel to the **Iao Needle**, an historic 1,200-foot stone pinnacle. Our next stop will be the **Maui Tropical Plantation** for shopping and a **narrated tour** through tropical fields of flowers and fruits. Sample the fruit and learn about the history of Hawaiian agriculture. Our tour ends with lunch at the **Waikapu Grill**.



We will then continue to the **Royal Lahaina Resort** where we will check in for two nights. Set amidst 27 tropical acres, this oceanfront hotel sits in a prime location along an exclusive half-mile stretch of Kaanapali Beach.



## Day 8 (B, D)

Breakfast is included at the hotel this morning before we depart on an **Island Marine Whale Watch Cruise**. Behold the elegance and grace of Pacific humpback whales in their native habitat. An expert will provide narration while we take advantage of the many photo opportunities that will present themselves. Underwater video equipment that is attached to the vessel, combined with on-board monitors, offer unparalleled whale viewing opportunities!

Following the cruise we will transfer to **Lahaina Town** for shopping, museum exploration and lunch on your own at one of the fine eateries in this old whaling town. There is a free shuttle that runs from Lahaina Town to our hotel so you can return to the hotel early to enjoy an afternoon of relaxation at the beach or by the pool, or you can stay in town late and shop 'til you drop!



